Student Teaching Evaluator

Requirements to Apply

- AMI diploma for the level of training
- A minimum of three years classroom experience at that level
- Training center staff or designate attests to quality implementation of AMI Standards
- Current membership in AMI

Application Documents

- AMI Application for Student Teaching Evaluator Certificate
- Copy of AMI Diploma for the level of training
- AMI Membership Number
- Personal Essay, addressing the criteria as listed on the Application Form
- Two professional letters of reference, addressing the criteria as listed on the Application Form

Training

- Signs Professional Expectations Agreement
- Receives training on completion of the Student Teaching Evaluation Form as used for the Training Course
- Accompanies Supervising Trainer or other course staff on a minimum of five student teaching evaluation visits
- Completes Student Teaching Evaluation Forms for each student; these are then discussed with the Supervising Trainer
- Observes Supervising Trainer or other course staff in student teaching feedback conferences with a minimum of two students
- Conducts feedback conferences with three students in the Supervising Trainer's presence

Assessment

- Demonstrates a high level of professionalism during onsite visits
- Provides clear, positive, constructive and objective feedback

Award of Certificate

- When all training requirements have been satisfied, the Supervising Trainer submits a positive Assessment Form to AMI
- AMI will award the PDS Certificate for Student Teaching Evaluator upon successful completion of the programme and submission of all required paperwork and fees
